

More Science Hints.....

Start each study session with review. Before you begin a new study session, spend a few minutes reviewing.

Be sure you understand the material. Ask questions if you do not.

Draw a picture. If you are having trouble understanding something, try a diagram. Making a picture of something you have read will often help you see how things fit together.

If you are given time in class to start or complete an assignment use it wisely!

Keep an organized notebook with all of your papers!

Don't just memorize! It does no good to simply memorize the facts or formulas – you should know the reasons behind formulas, and understand the laws, properties or concepts behind the facts.

Make flash cards. The writing and making of the flashcards helps put the information in your brain as you go through it, and is an excellent resource for test review and study.

Don't fall behind. Studying science is like climbing a ladder. Progress is made step by step.
