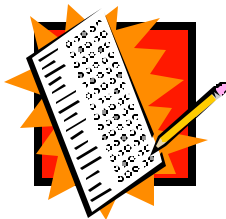


Science Test Correction Policy



When a Science test or quiz is returned, in addition to the test score it will usually have the student's current class average circled. Also, any missing assignments will be noted. In an effort to get students to review and learn from their quizzes and chapter tests, extra points for test corrections is offered. All tests and quizzes that include an average, regardless of the score, must be returned signed the next day

If a student has 70% or below on a test or quiz, they are **REQUIRED** to correct the test following the procedures outlined in class. Any student that has 71% or above, have the **OPTION** to correct their test for the extra points. Students are able to earn up to 20% of the missed points back. How many points they earn is determined by the quality of the corrections.

Correction procedure:

- ✓ Corrections must be on a separate paper attached to the test (never written in on the test)
- ✓ Students need to evaluate why they might of gotten the answer wrong and include this for each answer. (Did they not study that part, did they misread the question, did they give an answer that was incomplete etc.)
- ✓ The correct answer must be given and explained.
- ✓ They need to note how they know this is the correct answer (from the book, from notes, that they now have a clearer understanding of how to use the facts etc.)
- ✓ Corrections are due the day after the test is returned.

We go over all tests together in class when they are returned. Students have the opportunity to hear the correct answer and get an explanation if needed. They cannot copy the answers as we go along. They must go back and find it for themselves as a learning tool.
