How do you know if your child is ready to start kindergarten?

He/she should be able to do the following:

- ◆ sit quietly to listen to a story and tell you about it afterwards
- ◆ listen to and follow multiple step directions
- ◆ hold a pencil and write his/her name
- ◆ color and use scissors
- ◆ know the letter names and some of the sounds they make
- ◆ count and recognize the numbers 1 to 10

These skills and typical five-year-old maturity usually predict success in the beginning of kindergarten. If your child should experience difficulty at the beginning of kindergarten, OLA may recommend another year in preschool.
